Enrollment Procedures for Homeless Students:

The McKinney-Vento Act requires all local educational agencies to immediately enroll students in homeless situations, even if they do not have the required documents, such as school records, medical records, proof of residency, and other documents. The term 'enroll' is defined as attending classes and participating fully in school activities.

Could you be homeless?

Becoming homeless can happen to anyone. Every student in our district must have their parent/guardian fill out a Student Residency Questionnaire at enrollment. Please view our Student Residency Questionnaire to see if your child is considered homeless at this time. There are many services that your child may qualify for such as the following:

- Transportation to and from school
- Free breakfast and lunch
- School supplies
- Clothing
- Referrals for mental, health or other related services
- Emergency assistance
