  - What is UYN (Use your net smarts)

  - Check first with an adult before you meet anyone you meet online
  - Tell a trusted adult if anyone approaches you outside or online
  - Say no if you feel uncomfortable, confused or scared

  - When creating passwords, never use your real name
  - Never give out your password (except to your parents), even to your friends

  - Don't open attachments unless you know who they came from
  - Don't forward files, even if they came from someone you know unless you ask your parent

  - Never give out information like your name, age or information to people online
  - Tell an adult you trust if anyone asks you for personal information
