 - o Check first with an adult before you meet anyone you meet online
 - Tell a trusted adult if anyone approaches you outside or online
 - Say no if you feel uncomfortable, confused or scared
- The Password Rap
 - When creating passwords, never use your real name
 - Never give out your password (except to your parents), even to your friends
- Don't Open that File
 - o Don't open attachments unless your know who they came from
 - Don't forward files, even if they came from someone you know unless you ask your parent
- <u>The Boy Who Loved IM</u>
 - What you see isn't always what you get
 - Never give out information lke your name, age or information to people online
 - Tell an adult you trust if anyone asks you for personal information
- Beat the Tricks
 - Tricks that strangers might use to get you to leave with them
- <u>UYN: The NetSmartz Chat Abbreviation Rap</u>
 - o Play rap several times and encourage kids to join in
