Signs a Child is Struggling

- Changes in Behavior
- Anxiety, fear or worry about safety
- Increase of complaints: headaches, stomachaches, unable to sleep or over sensitive to minor • Loss of Appetite or bumps
- Avoidance of going places Isolation

- Difficulty with redirection or criticism
- Sleep changes: nightmares, bedwetting, sleeping more,
- Overeating
