- Inspire parents and community members to participate with the school district in enriching teaching.





Purpose

To encourage and facilitate new and innovative practice for improving teaching and learning in Dickinson ISD.

Eligibility

Any individual or teams employed by Dickinson ISD are eligible to apply for grants.

Application Closes: 09/24/2021

2.) Principal Selection

Principal's grant selection deadline is 10/08/2021

3.) Grant Review Committee

Final grant selection will be made on 10/21/2021 by the committee

4.) Prize Patrol

Grant Award Day(1): **11/03/2021**Grant Award Day(2): **11/04/2021**



5.) Purchasing Deadline

All funds must be encumbrance or expensed by **04/30/2022**, grant funds will not roll over or be available after this date.
