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What is Disability Insurance?

When you get sick or injured, you want to focus on getting well – not on worrying about how to pay the bills or afford next week's groceries. Disability Insurance may replace a portion of your income. Enrolling in Disability helps you protect your paycheck if you were to suffer an injury or illness that left you unable to work.

Designed with school employees like you in mind, Educator Disability ensures you get the coverage you need when it matters most.

These plans can let you choose the amount of money you'll receive every month, when your benefits begin and how long you'll receive the cash benefit.

You may choose an Elimination Period(injury/sickness) of 0/7, 14/14, 30/30, 60/60, 90/90or 180/180 days.

If, because of your disability, you are hospital confined as an inpatient, benefits begin on the first day of inpatient confinement.

Inpatient means that you are confined to a hospital room due to your sickness or injury for 23 or more consecutive hours.

(Applies to Elimination Periods of 30 days or less.)

Crustless sausage & spinach quiche



INGREDENTS

- 3 links sweet Italian turkey or chicken sausage, removed from casing (8.5 ounces total)
- 12 ounce bag baby spinach
- 1 cup grated light havarti or cheddar
- 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 2/3 cup 2% milk
- 1/4 cup half & half cream
- 5 large eggs
- 3/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/8 teaspoon ground black pepper
- pinch freshly grated nutmeg

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat your oven to 350 degrees. Spray a pie dish with oil.
- Cook the sausage in a large skillet over medium heat, breaking up until cooked, about 5 minutes.
- Add the spinach and reduce heat to low, cook until wilted stirring occasionally, about 7 minutes.
 Drain spinach well.
- Evenly spread the spinach sausage mixture in the prepared dish and top it evenly with the grated havarti and parmesan cheese.
- Make the custard mixture by whisking together the milk, half and half, eggs, salt, black pepper, and the nutmeg.
- Pour the custard into the dish and bake 35 to 40 minutes, until the center is set.

You can access your digital ID card through the
BlueAccess for Members Portal (BAM)

at any time. You can text "BCBSTXAPP" to 336633 to download the digital app to access your digital ID card and more. You can also call a Personal Health Care Guide at 866-355-5999 and they can email you a temporary card or order a new ID card to be mailed to you.

If you have not changed your healthcare plans, you can continue to use your old ID card. New ID cards will not be mailed out to individuals who did not make any changes for the new plan year.

If you are a new enrollee or made changes to your plan, your new ID cards will be mailed out in batches starting mid September. Please keep in mind that these will be mailed to the address you have listed on file in the Employee Access Center.
